Not everyone thinks as laterally as Andreas Fabian, the British-based German designer responsible for the Hemding platter cum fruit bowl. The delightful creation is one of Thorsten van Elten's latest pieces – he spotted it at the Milan Furniture Fair last year and decided to help Fabian produce the piece. It's now available to buy and there are three options: Hemding with a new ash handle costs £125; with a vintage handle, £109; or you can supply your own handle and pay £95 to have Fabian transform it into your very own Hemding.
